

This conference is a unique opportunity for researchers, students and investment professionals to present research, identify research opportunities and build partnerships to continue to enhance our knowledge of responsible investment. Please note that those wishing to submit a paper or workshop to PRI should follow the links on one of the three applicable prizes even though they may be putting forward a paper they don't want to be considered for a prize or a workshop idea.

The purpose of the 2012 Academic Conference is to develop understanding of the complexity of institutions, organizations, strategies and processes that make up responsible investment. We invite submissions for sessions on topics that address one or more of the following themes:

Investment strategies;

Shareholder engagement and collective action;

Public policy and regulation;

Organizations and organizational change;

Market structures and systemic change.

As with previous years, the conference is coordinated with the [Finance and Sustainability awards](#) so that applicants need only apply one time to be considered for the conference and awards.
