### **Creating Hope and Opportunity from the Earth of Africa**

Situated on what was once part of a coffee plantation, there is now a small workshop where ceramic jewellery is made by Kenyan women. Many are supporting an "extended family" of 20 or more.

It is painstaking work. Each bead has to be shaped, polished, fired, painted and fired again. The result is **KAZURI**, the Swahili word for "small and beautiful."

### **Grandmothers' Campaign**

The Stephen Lewis Foundation launched the Grandmothers' Campaign in response to the emerging crisis faced by African grandmothers as they struggle to care for millions of children orphaned by AIDS. The Campaign aims to raise awareness, build solidarity and mobilize support in Canada for Africa's grandmothers.
