

Terms

Awarded annually to an outstanding student entering the Bachelor of Humanities, Bachelor of Arts in Greek and Roman Studies, or the Bachelor of Arts in Religion in the College of the Humanities (or any additional undergraduate degree program in the College of the Humanities) at Carleton University. Eligible students must be Canadian Citizens or permanent residents of Canada (landed immigrant or a protected person) and must demonstrate a strong academic background and participation in extra-curricular activities. Students who study abroad as part of any undergraduate degree program within the College of the Humanities are eligible to hold this scholarship in their year abroad. This scholarship is renewable up to four years. Application is required. Endowed in 2008 by Pamela and Richard Joho to honour their commitment to a classical education.

This scholarship is valued at \$7,000 for the 2017/2018 academic year and renewable for second, third and fourth year with an annual GPA of 10.0 or better (please refer to general eligibility criteria below).

Application Deadline: May 1, 2017

Only one scholarship will be awarded

General Eligibility Criteria

- Student entering the first year of an undergraduate degree program with the College of the Humanities at Carleton University (eligible programs include: Bachelor of Humanities, Bachelor of Arts in Greek and Roman Studies, Bachelor of Arts in Religion)
- Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person
- Demonstrate participation in extra-curricular activities
- Demonstrate strong academic background (minimum admission average 90% required)
- Pursuing post-secondary studies for the first time
- This scholarship is renewable over the first four years of undergraduate study provided the recipient maintains full time enrolment (minimum of 4.0 credits over the Fall/Winter session) in The College of the Humanities and achieves an annual GPA of 10.0 or better.
- For awards, all grades (grade points of all Carleton credits/courses) from the previous Summer, Fall, and Winter terms are included in the calculation of the annual GPA.
- If the scholarship is lost in one year, it cannot be regained in a subsequent year
