## Integration of Immigrants in Sweden: Employment, Housing and Voting

This talk discusses the labour market integration of men and women in the Netherlands and Sweden, the political participation of immigrants and minorities in their host society and the attitudes of the native population towards immigrants and other minority groups. Pieter Bevelander is Associate Professor and works as a researcher at Malmö Institute of Migration, Diversity and Welfare and as senior lecturer at Malmö University, Sweden. His main research field is international migration and different aspects of immigrant integration, including comparisons of ethnic social capital in Canada and the Netherlands. He has a doctorate in economic history. A number of his publications deal with the labour market situation of immigrants in a regional setting and the effects of labour market policy measures directed towards immigrants in Netherlands and Sweden.
