

## "Europe-Russia-USA and the Conflict in Ukraine"

with Wendelin Ettmayer

Based on long experience as a diplomat, the former Austrian Ambassador to Canada will discuss the state of relations between Europe, the US, and Russia in light of the Ukraine crisis. He will place current developments in historical perspective, considering the post-Cold War increase in Western power and influence, while Russia lost much of what it had gained during the previous 300 years. Dr. Ettmayer will explore the shift in power implied by the crisis and consider factors underlying EU responses.

Wendelin Ettmayer is the former Austrian Ambassador to Finland (1994-2000), Canada (2000-2003), and the Council of Europe (2005-2008). He was a Member of the Austrian National Parliament for 16 years and the former Head of the Department for Bilateral and Multilateral Economic Relations in the Austrian Foreign Ministry. He has a doctorate in law from the University of Vienna and is the author of several books.
