



Grants to support participation in the EU Study Tour 2013 (May 5-25, 2013)

The **Centre of European Studies** will be offering grants to assist student participation in the EU Study Tour and Internship; they are awarded on the basis of financial need.

Applicants must be accepted to participate in the EU Study Tour and Internships Program through Carleton University in order to be eligible for a grant. The deadline for applying to EU Tour and Internship program through Carleton has been extended to February 4, 2013 (however applications received by the original deadline of January 28, 2013 will be given advance consideration). The maximum value of a grant is about \$1750. Applications for grants are due at noon on **February 20, 2013**. Applications should include a brief letter requesting a grant, indicating:

- (a) an indication of other sources of funding for participation in the Tour and Internship, and for 2013 summer studies (including sources applied or which you intend to apply for but not yet received)
- (b) an estimate of costs for summer study, including the EU Tour and Internship
- (c) the amount of the requested grant.
