CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Short-term visitor for an EU scholar at Carleton University, Ottawa, Canada European Integration and EU-Canada Relations August – September 2016

The Centre for European Studies (CES, <u>www.carleton.ca/ces</u>), an EU Centre of Excellence at Carleton University in Ottawa, Canada, invites applications for a position as a short-term visitor for a period of two to four weeks in August-September 2016; a portion of the visit should take place in September to correspond to the academic term which begins on September 7, 2016.

The visitor will be expected to participate in the outreach activities of the Centre, including a public talk and other outreach activities, to consult with students and to teach or co-teach two class sessions with a Carleton instructor. CES will attempt to assist the visitor with research contacts in Canada; the visitor may also have the opportunity to give a guest lecture at another EU Centre in Canada or at a regional university.

Eligibility: Applicants should hold an ongoing position at an academic institution in the EU and should have expertise in European integration or EU-Canada relations. The Centre is particularly interested in applicants with expertise relating to EU as a global actor, EU-Canada relations, or the EU's relations with countries included in the Eastern Partnership policy or with Russia. Applicants should be fluent in English.

We are seeking applicants with a completed Ph.D. in a relevant field and with a record of publication, research, and teaching in the field. The short-term visitor will receive a stipend to help cover travel (economy) and accommodation expenses, and a modest living allowance as allowed under the EU Commission and university guidelines.

Applicants should send a letter of application, a curriculum vitae, two reference letters, and a copy of a recent publication relating to a topic of relevance to this competition to the following email address no later than **March 28, 2016**: CanadaEU@carleton.ca. In the subject title line of the email, please indicate, *Short term visitor application YOUR NAME*. Letters of reference should be sent to the same email address with the subject title line of the email, *Short term visitor reference APPLICANT NAME*.
