Day 2: Saturday, June 11, 2016

Amsterdam, Netherlands - Tour Begins - Board Ship

Your tour opens in Amsterdam where you board your ship for a relaxing 14-night river cruise. Day 4: Monday, June 13, 2016


Cologne - Koblenz, Germany

Cruise the scenic Rhine River to Cologne, one of Germany's oldest cities. **A guided tour through the old part of the city highlights the twin steepled, 13th-century Gothic cathedral.** Continue to Koblenz, at the confluence of the Rhine and Moselle rivers. *(B, L, D)*

Day 5: Tuesday, June 14, 2016

Koblenz - Rudesheim

Enjoy exploring the quintessential German town of Koblenz on your own before continuing your cruise through a beautiful stretch of the Rhine. Sail past the dramatic Rhine Gorge, dotted with hilltop castles. You will see the legendary Lorelei Rock before arriving in Rudesheim, a charming Rhine Valley wine town. **The "Winzerexpress" mini-train takes**



you to Siegfried's Mechanical Musical Instrument Museum for a guided tour. Explore the historic pedestrian street Drosselgasse on your own before returning to the ship. *(B, L, D)*

**Day 6: Wednesday, June 15, 2016
Excursion to Miltenberg and Wertheim**

Today you disembark in Miltenberg where you will have an included walking tour followed by free time to discover the city including its enchanting market square. Next, continue to Wertheim where you will visit the famous Glass Museum. Before returning to the ship, enjoy time on your own to stroll its cobblestone streets lined with gabled, half-timbered houses. *(B, L, D)*

**Day 7: Thursday, June 16, 2016
Würzburg**

Arrive in Würzburg, the "Pearl of the Romantic Road." Nearly destroyed during WW II, Würzburg has been rebuilt into a beautiful Franconian town. **Visit fascinating sights including the magnificent Prince-Bishops Residence, a UNESCO World Heritage site.** Continue

cruising through the pastoral Franconian wine region. *(B, L, D)*

**Day 8: Friday, June 17, 2016 Bamberg
Enter the Main-Danube Canal at Bamberg, a UNESCO World Heritage site.**

Disembark and enjoy a guided tour to discover the history of this medieval gem, founded in 902. Later, continue to sail along the canal on your way to medieval Nuremberg. *(B, L, D)*

**Day 9: Saturday, June 18, 2016
Nuremberg - Kelheim**

Depart on a guided tour of picturesque Nuremberg, Bavaria's second largest city. You will be awed by the 900-year-old ramparts, the Imperial Castle and the Justice Palace. Later, arrive at the highest point of your cruise before descending through the impressive stair-step locks. *(B, L, D)*

**Day 10: Sunday, June 19, 2016
Kelheim - Regensburg**

Cruise through the final stretch of the Main-Danube Canal before arriving in magnificent Regensburg. Founded 2,000 years ago, Regensburg stands as one of Germany's best-preserved medieval cities. **A city walk features the old Town Hall, the 12th-century**



Stone Bridge, St. Peter's Cathedral and the Porta Praetoria. Tonight, feel like a local at a typical Bavarian evening onboard the ship. (B, L, D)

Day 11: Monday, June 20, 2016

Passau - Linz, Austria

Arrive in Passau, where the rivers Inn and Ilz join the Danube. Get acquainted with this beautiful city on a walking tour. Discover its gems including St. Stephan's Cathedral and the world's largest church organ.

Cruise to stunning Linz, a favourite of Mozart, who dedicated his *Linz Symphony* to this town. Take a stroll through the city with a local expert before rejoining the ship. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Tuesday, June 21, 2016

Wachau Valley - Vienna

Relax and enjoy the surrounding scenery as you cruise past Melk Abbey, a magnificent 900-year-old Benedictine Abbey, and one of Europe's largest Baroque monasteries.

This afternoon, continue cruising through the romantic Wachau Valley, dotted with magnificent castles and small riverside towns.

You arrive in Vienna, Austria's

beautiful capital city, in the early evening. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Wednesday, June 22, 2016

Vienna

Join a local expert exploring Vienna's Imperial architecture including the Hofburg Palace, the Vienna Opera House, the Ringstrasse and St. Stephen's Cathedral. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore the city as you choose. Tonight, cruise to Slovakia. (B, L, D)

Day 14: Thursday, June 23, 2016

Bratislava, Slovakia

Tour Slovakia's remarkable capital, Bratislava, and discover the city's celebrated sites including the 13th-century castle, the old town, St. Martin's Cathedral, Michael's Gate and the Archbishop's palace. The afternoon is at leisure. **Tonight, you are invited to attend the Captain's Gala Dinner before departing for Hungary.** (B, L, D)

Budapest, Hungary

Embark on a tour of Budapest, Hungary's lovely capital, featuring its historic Buda Castle area, Fisherman's

Bastion and 500-year-old St. Matthias Church. Enjoy splendid views as you sail between the twin cities of Buda and Pest, nestled on opposing banks of the river. **Tonight, gather onboard with your fellow travellers for a farewell dinner.** After dinner, take in the essence of the region during an evening cruise to view Budapest's stunning night skyline followed by a fun-filled folklore show. *(B, L, D)*

Discover the world of glass making from A to Z in two adjacent historic timbered homes built in the 1500s that are now home to the Glass Museum in Wertheim, Germany. Stroll through thousands of years of history in exhibits featuring glass creations that date back to ancient Egypt and Rome. Witness the fascinating craft in action when you watch a talented glassblower work his magic right before your eyes. View an array of festive Christmas ornaments made of glass, a world-renowned craft in Germany. Be introduced to the colourful creations of young glass artists in the museum's temporary exhibition area. This one-of-a-kind museum gleams with beautiful art and immerses you in the unique world of glass.

Itinerary is also subject to change due to unforeseen changes in water levels, delays at the locks, and other circumstances that may arise along the waterways. These changes may include items being missed during the trip; however, every effort will be made to substitute another attraction if possible.

Due to various flight arrival times and the boarding time of the cruise ship, we have reserved meeting space at a centrally-located hotel where you will meet your tour manager and fellow travellers and relax before boarding your cruise ship.

To complete your tour, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Single accommodations are extremely limited. Triple and Child accommodations are not available.

Ports of call are subject to change based on pier availability and weather conditions. Smart casual wear is recommended throughout the trip. For the welcome and farewell dinners, a dinner dress for the ladies and jacket and tie for the gentlemen is

recommended. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended throughout the trip.

Gratuities for cabin stewards, bus boys and waiters onboard the ship are not included. Coffee or tea is included at all meals. Wine, beer and soda are included with each dinner on-board the ship.

Embarkation on day 2 is after 4:00 p.m.; on day 16, disembarkation is normally at 9:00 a.m.

Cabins are available on lower (Hadyen), middle (Strauss) and upper (Mozart) decks. Please note that river cruises are smaller ships and only have a finite number of each cabin category available. Specific categories are available on a first come first served basis.

Every effort will be made to accommodate your cabin choice at time of booking; however, if that cabin category is no longer available, the closest available category will be offered.

Please see pricing for cost of any upgrade fees for different cabin categories. Suites are available (Amadeus Suites) on a very limited basis and are not available to guests travelling as singles.

This tour includes moderate physical activity. The itinerary blends some longer days with

shorter days and more leisure time. Walking tours, as well as walking slightly longer distances, up stairs or on uneven walking surfaces should be expected.

The cruise line reserves the right to charge a supplemental fuel charge. Should this charge be incurred, you will be notified in advance.

Budapest

Szentendre

\$57 CAD

Visit Szentendre, a Hungarian town that became an artist settlement in 1926. Explore this area, including the main square, surrounded by impressive buildings from the Rococo and Baroque periods. View the parish church dedicated to John the Baptist, and don't miss the sundial in front of the church, possibly the world's oldest still operational sundial. The above option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 3.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Nuremberg

Nuremberg Documentation Centre

\$63 CAD

Visit the Nuremberg Documentation Centre and view the permanent exhibition entitled "Fascination and Terror," which examines the causes, context and consequences of the National Socialist reign during the years of the Third Reich. The Documentation Centre is located on the former Nazi party rally grounds, where propagandist rallies were held from 1933 until 1938. To this day, the remains of the buildings with their immense proportions are a vivid testimony to the megalomania of the National Socialist regime. This area of eleven square kilometers was intended as an impressive backdrop for the Nazi party to demonstrate their power, and today the site serves as a poignant reminder of the past. The above option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. Price is subject to change at any time prior to purchase. *Duration: Approximately 3 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Würzburg

Excursion to Rothenburg

Travel to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, Germany's well-preserved "Jewel of the Middle Ages," with both Renaissance and Gothic influences. Upon arrival in Rothenburg, enjoy a locally guided walking tour highlighting the towers, city gates, walls, and picturesque half-timbered gables of the town – all of which have remained unchanged for centuries. View the St. Jakob parish church, which houses Tilman Riemenschneider's masterpiece, the Holy Blood Alter (Heiligblutaltar). Enjoy leisure time in Rothenburg before returning to the ship. The above option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. Price is subject to change at any time prior to purchase. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Vienna

Schönbrunn Palace

Travel from the port via motorcoach to one of Vienna's most beautiful buildings, the Schönbrunn Palace. Schönbrunn Palace was modelled after the palace of Versailles, the residence of King Louis XIV (Le Roi Soleil) and was the long time summer residence of the Hapsburgs. You will have the opportunity to view the province apartments and ceremonial rooms, and then take a stroll through the palace's beautiful gardens. The Schönbrunn Palace is one of Austria's treasures and a sight to be seen! The above option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 3.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Bratislava

Imperial Festival Palace - Castle Hof

\$75 CAD

Only a short hour's drive from Vienna is the Slovakian capital of Bratislava. Here you will find the fascinating baroque architectural marvel, the Palace Hof Imperial Festival. Baroque wonders fill the imperial castles of the Marchfeld, which were erected for Prince Eugen of Savoy in the 18th century and later expanded by Maria Theresia and the Viennese Court to become Austria's largest ensemble of country castles. The Hof Castle had also been known as the site of splendid events since its construction in 1726. Here, wood turners, basket weavers and pewter smiths practice their crafts, races of rare pets such as Wallachian sheep or white donkeys are held, and a jam kitchen and distillery take care of bodily comforts. Even organic fruits and vegetables are cultivated here and can be tasted during your visit. *Duration: Approximately 4.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Vienna

Sound of Vienna Concert

\$88 CAD

Enjoy an evening full of music. A special orchestra event in a local venue sparks off a unique firework of the most beautiful compositions from the king of waltz, Johann Strauss, as well as beloved Mozart. Excellent musicians, opera singers and magical ballet dancers present an evening full of Viennese charm with beautiful waltzes, polkas and operetta melodies performed at their highest level. The above option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 3 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Kelheim

The Weltenberg Monastery

Travel via motorcoach to Kelheim. Upon arrival board excursion boats which travel through the Weltenburger Enge nature reserve (the Danube rise) to the Benedictine abbey of Weltenburg. The monastery, founded by Irish or Scottish monks in 620 AD, is the oldest monastery in Bavaria. Take a short tour of the abbey church. Then, indulge in a true local favourite when you sample the famous dark beer of Weltenburg, brewed on site in the oldest monastery brewery in the world. This is the perfect opportunity to really explore some of Germany's traditional countryside and historic sites. The above option is only available until 15 days prior to departure. After this time, the option may be purchased once you are on board the cruise ship directly from the cruise line. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Budapest

Gödöllő Castle and Horse Show

\$75 CAD

Travel to Gödöllő Castle, a short distance from Budapest. The castle was built in the 18th century, and quickly became the symbol of the much beloved Hungarian Empress Elizabeth ("Sissi"). Nestled in an enormous park, Gödöllő Castle is the largest complex of Baroque buildings in Hungary. Later, visit a traditional csarda (horse farm) for a chance to witness an unforgettable performance of Hungarian horsemanship. *Duration: Approximately 4.5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 1 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
