INDIA

- From the peaks of the Himalayas to the Indian Ocean in the south, India's history and culture reaches back 5 thousand years
- One of the oldest civilizations in the world
- Population 1.2 Billion (per World Bank)
- 7th largest country in area
- 2nd largest country in population
- The largest democracy in the world

Legacy of India

- Home to the Ancient Indus Valley Civilization from 3000 to 1500 BC (known for its grid pattern of town planning) and a region of historic trade routes and vast empires
- A Religions Hinduism, Buddhism, Jainism, Sikhism originated here; whereas, Zoroastrianism, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam arrived in the 1st millennium and shaped the region's diverse culture.

Impact of Colonization

- Had 23% of the world's GDP when the British colonizers arrived and it fell to less than 4% when they left after 200 years of Colonial rule.
- Again struggling to regain the lost glory and is presently the 7th largest in GDP.
- Average rate of increase in GDP in the last decade is more than 6%.

- Has 22 official languages
- Each State/Region has its own local folk art, music, dance and dress.

Cultural ethos

- Indian cultural history spans more than 4,500 years. During the Vedic period 1700 to 500 BC the foundations of Indian Philosophy, mythology, theology and literature were laid.
- Since then it has been known for its religious and cultural diversity.
- The early scriptures Ramayana and Mahabharatha were compiled hundreds of years before Christ.

Christianity in India

- Is the 3rd largest religion with 27.8 million (2.7 crores) followers. It was introduced by St Thomas who visited Kerala in AD 52.
- Islam is the second largest religion with 14.2% or roughly 172 million (17 Crores). Is home to 10% of the world muslim population.



Challenges before us

- Police is over-burdened
- 2. Modern technology limited to urban centers
- 3. Crime investigation to be separated from Law and Order in rural areas as well
- 4. Judicial reforms as court pendency is heavy
- 5. Pay-scale of policemen is low
- 6. More emphasis needed on training

Naxal Insurgency

- Maoist insurgency is an ongoing conflict between Maoists groups, known as Naxalites and the Indian States.
- Has a long history of 42 years
- They do not believe in the parliamentary democracy.
- Profess and practice path of armed struggle as the only way of meeting aspirations of the masses.
- Mao: Power flows from the barrel of the gun.

Strategy and Tactics of LWE

- Instigate revolution to overthrow "state" through violence – a protracted people's war.
- To join and exploit any controversial issue in order to destabilize/expose govts.
- Opportunistic intervention in electoral politics against ruling party.
- To deter investment and development in some interior and other areas which are also rich in vital resources.
- Mass and Frontal organisations.

Student Islamic Movement of India

- Formed in Aligarh in 1977 Liberation of India from Western materialistic cultural influence and to convert society to live as per Muslim code of conduct.

- Maintains that concepts of secularism, democracy and nationalism, keystones of Indian Constitution, are antithetical to Islam.
