Transit to Carleton University

Take the **0-Train** to campus this fall. Ride in comfort aboard the modern Light Rail Bombardier Talent
Train. The O-Train runs between Greenboro

Train. The O-Train runs between Greenboro Station in the south and Bayview Station in the north, with a handy stop right in the heart of campus. Service runs seven days a week and every 15 minutes in most time periods. Use your transit pass or buy a \$2.50 O-Train ticket. Please remember — always use the pedestrian tunnel to cross the tracks.

If the train is not along your route, then the bus is still a fast, easy and economical way of getting to campus.

- Routes 4 and 7 operate on campus all day, seven days a week. Catch route 4 downtown on Rideau, Wellington or Bank Streets, or transfer to route 4 at Hurdman or Billings Bridge Stations. Route 4 is also your connection to the intercity bus terminal. Catch route 7 downtown on Bank or Rideau Streets.
- Route 117 serves the campus Monday to Friday and connects with Algonquin College. Catch the bus at Baseline Station or along Meadowlands.

Accessible Transit

More than half of OC Transpo's fleet is fully accessible, including the O-Train. So if you're able to get to a bus stop, then chances are you can ride conventional transit. For more information, contact us at 613-842-3625.

You can ride your bike, then lock it up and hop on a bus for a relaxing ride downtown. Or, take your bike with you on the O-Train (use door with green bike symbol). *Got a car?* Use one of our conveniently located Park & Ride lots and let us worry about the traffic.

Black routes generally run all day, seven days a week. Red and green routes run during peak periods on weekdays only, and green routes require

stops. Or, call 613-560-1000 *plus* the 4-digit number on your bus stop flag. For Carleton O-Train Station, call **613-560-1000** *plus* **3062**. Call 613-741-4390 seven days a week for information on routes and trip planning, and to receive free maps and timetables.

Fares - Save with a Student Pass

Pay with cash (exact change), tickets or pass, but save the most with a discounted student pass for *full-time* students

living in Ontario, age 27 or younger. The correct fare is displayed in the bus windshield.

Buy bus tickets and monthly passes on campus, at OC Transpo Sales Centres and at over 350 vendors in the city. Semester passes can also be bought on campus, at OC Transpo Sales Centres and at City of Ottawa Client Service Centres. Annual passes are only available at OC Transpo Sales Centres. A low-

cost Pass Protection Plan for lost or stolen annual passes is available at the time of purchase.

Semester passes available for fall, winter and summer!

Purchase an O-Train ticket from the vending machine on the station platform just before you travel.

You'll need an OC Transpo photo ID (\$5.75) to go with your pass. Get your picture taken at the Campus Card Office when you get your Carleton student photo ID. Or, go to an OC Transpo Sales and Information Centre with a piece of photo identification, proof of age, and your official timetable or tuition receipt showing full-time status. Photo IDs will also be sold at City Hall and the City of Ottawa Client Service Centre in Kanata, Mondays through Fridays from August 24 to September 11 (excl. Sept. 7) and September 21 to October 2, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
