Submitted abstracts must include:

- 1) The names of all authors with the presenting author and institutional affiliation indicated
- 2) The student's department, program type (BA, BSc, MA, MSc, PhD, etc), and supervisor's name
- 3) The presentation title
- 4) Preference for an oral or poster presentation
- 5) An abstract of maximum 250 words, which should include a brief introduction of your topic, research objectives, approach/methods and key findings
