Submission Guidelines

1. Entrants must be the sole proprietor of their image;
2. Only northern images will be valid for entry; *
3. Photos must be entered into one category of best fit (please include chosen category in email):
 - a. ***Northern Communities, Cultures, and Research;***
 - b. ***Northern Landscapes;***
 - c. ***Northern Fauna and Flora;***
4. A maximum of two photos per category may be entered into the contest (maximum six photos per photographer);
5. Photos should be your highest resolution .JPG or .TIFF format;
6. File names should follow the format firstname_lastname#.jpg;
7. Each photo should have its own distinct caption including location and date taken included in the body of the email submission;
8. Any entry that depicts a recognizable person must be accompanied by a Model Release Form;
9. Entire entry must be less than 10MB;

Eligibility

1. Current students or recent graduates of Carleton University or University of Ottawa;
2. Professional photographers are not eligible;
3. Agree with the terms stated in the submission guidelines;

Judging

Contest entries will be judged on originality, composition, technical execution and overall impact. The judging panel will be composed of OCSNRS 2014 committee members and Carleton photographers.

Prizes

Prizes will be awarded in each category for a first place winner and a runner up.

Copyright Notice

The photographer retains copyright of all photographs submitted to this contest. Upon entering the contest, the photographer grants OCSNRS the right to display all photos during the 2015 symposium.
