Paper and poster presentations are open to current undergraduate, master's and doctoral students, as well as recent graduates (since January 2014). It is an excellent way to practice presenting and gain valuable feedback from your peers!

Abstracts are welcome in French or English. Presentations may range from project proposals to publication ready results. Northern research eligibility is defined using the same criteria as the [Northern Scientific Training Program](#).

Submitted abstracts must include:

- (1) The names of all authors with the presenting author and institutional affiliation indicated
- (2) The student's department, program type (BA, BSc, MA, MSc, PhD, etc), and supervisor's name
- (3) The presentation title
- (4) Preference for an oral or a poster presentation
- (5) An abstract of 250 words maximum, which should include a brief introduction to your topic, research objectives, approach/methods and key findings.
