NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

Description of the Field

The term 'non-governmental organizations' encompasses a wide variety of private and public organizations involved in activities ranging from health and educational services to scientific and public policy research. NGOs can be grouped into three major categories according to their general purpose: assistance organizations, exchange organizations (build intellectual connections and professional networks via cultural and educational exchange), and foundations and associations (provide funding, information and other services for constituencies). Increasingly, NGOs are used as executing agencies by donors – those who carry out the work in the field.

More and more people are finding employment in the non-profit sector and this trend is likely to accelerate. The rapid growth of the field increases competition for philanthropic dollars and consequently, excellent writing skills, project management abilities and ability to elicit cooperation from diverse constituencies are among the skills being sought by employers. Workers are likely to handle a variety of duties and have significant responsibility earlier on in their career. Those with careers in the non-profit world tend to be hardworking idealists, service oriented and less concerned with financial rewards. Working conditions of employees can be difficult and pay is often low.
