Rethinking Abortion, Ectogenesis, and Fetal Death

The aim of this paper is not to give a defence of abortion. Instead it is concerned with a) what abortion is; and b) what rights women hold with respect to abortion. Does a woman who has an abortion have a right to the death of her fetus? Is ectogenesis a "solution" to the abortion debate, by providing an alternative location for the fetus if it can be removed alive from the uterus? I explain how and why my views on the answers to these questions have changed.
