The Gwich'in Tribal Council (GTC) is seeking two highly motivated Community Gwich'in Language Programmers. Reporting to the Language Revitalization Specialist, the Community Gwich'in Language Programmers are responsible for initiatives focused on the preservation of the Gwich'in language. This includes the coordination of language promotion, maintenance, education, and revitalization activities in their home community (Tsiigehtchic – Gwichya dialect; and Fort McPherson – Teetlit dialect).

The ideal applicant should have fluency in Gwich'in language (oral and written), and two years of related experience, including experience with language instruction or promotion. A Certificate or Diploma in a language or education related field would be considered an asset. Equivalencies (combinations of education and experience) may be considered.

The position is part-time (20 hours per week). Salary will commensurate with education and experience. The GTC offers a generous and competitive benefits package.
