(July 2 – August 23, 2025)

Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for full-time OSAP assistance for the 2025 Late Summer Session you must:

- meet all OSAP eligibility requirements, be enrolled in a Degree or Certificate program that is approved for OSAP purposes;
- register and remain registered in a summer course load that meets or exceeds OSAP's minimum requirement;

Additionally, to apply for OSAP funding for just the May/June Early Summer study period you must have received full-time OSAP funding in 2024-2025 fall and/or winter terms.

Deadline

- The submission deadline for the May/June Early Summer study period is July 14, 2025.
- Email the completed form to the Awards Office at awards@carleton.ca.

OSAP Early Summer Extension forms will only be processed if they have been completed in full and submitted via email ahead of the study period deadline. Any documents required to support your extension form must also be received by the Awards Office prior to the deadline.
