Eligibility Requirements

To be considered for full-time OSAP assistance for the 2026 Early Summer Session you must:

- meet all OSAP eligibility requirements, be enrolled in a Degree or Certificate program that is approved for OSAP purposes;
- register and remain registered in a summer course load that meets or exceeds OSAP's minimum requirement;

Additionally, to apply for OSAP funding for just the May/June Early Summer study period you must have received full-time OSAP funding in 2025-2026 fall and/or winter terms.

Deadline

OSAP Early Summer Extension Requests will only be processed by the Awards Office if they have been completed in full and submitted electronically ahead of the published deadlines. The submission deadline for the May/June Early Summer study period is **May 18, 2026**.

Any documents required to support your extension request must also be received by the Awards Office prior to the deadline.
