## **Professor Lee Ward**

Dr. Lee Ward is Professor of Political Science at Baylor University. Before joining Baylor in 2017 he was Alpha Sigma Nu Distinguished Professor of Political Science in Campion College at the University of Regina. He also previously taught as a Visiting Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Science at Kenyon College in Gambier, Ohio and was the Bradley Post-Doctoral Fellow in the Program in Constitutional Government at Harvard University.

He received a BA from the University of Toronto, an MA from Brock University and a PhD from Fordham University in New York City. He is the author of *The Politics of Liberty in England and Revolutionary America* (Cambridge, 2004), *John Locke and Modern Life* (Cambridge, 2010), *Modern Democracy and the Theological-Political Problem in Spinoza, Rousseau and Jefferson* (Palgrave McMillan, 2014) and *Recovering Classical Political Economy* (Edinburgh University Press 2022)
