



CALL FOR ABSTRACTS Sustainable Ocean Conference

The Dalhousie Marine Affairs Program is proud to host its **11th annual Sustainable Ocean Conference**, September 23rd-24th in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

Overview:

The **Sustainable Ocean Conference** is the only student-led event of its kind in Atlantic Canada. It is supported by the **Sobey Fund For Oceans**, a partnership between Dalhousie University, and the Marine Affairs Program dedicated to supporting students and ocean conservation initiatives. This conference is a free event aiming to bring together students and faculty, members of the marine management community and the general public.

The theme of this year's conference is *Dive Deeper*. It will investigate complex topics of ocean conservation and sustainability by navigating below the surface of current marine issues. The conference will focus on three sub-themes including the North, early-career scientists, and marine protected areas and investigate their potential connections.

Prizes will be awarded for the top speakers and poster presentations.
