

Access instructions


- The building sits at the corner of Campus Avenue and University Drive.
- In google maps enter: Campus Ave & University Dr. or use this link in Google Maps: <https://maps.app.goo.gl/U2mtaBGNQKR6WidF9>
- Participants are asked to enter through the **rear entrance of Richcraft Hall (closer to the river)** rather than the main entrance.
- Using the elevator or the stairs, take floor 2R (**not** floor 2). Exiting the elevator or the stairs, you will find room 2440R on your left.

Transit

If travelling by transit from downtown Ottawa, you have the following options.

Option 1: O-Train - Line 1 from Parliament to Bayview, then Line 2 from Bayview to Carleton.

Option 2: Bus 7 from Bank/Slater to Carleton.

Option 3: Bus 10 from Lyon to Carleton.

You will then need to walk about 400m along Campus Avenue, heading toward the river, to reach Richcraft Hall.
