## COURSE DESCRIPTION / INSTRUCTOR'S STATEMENT

The seminar examines various approaches to the study of Canada, through readings and in person discussion; in-person research sessions at the National archives and at the Museums are planned. We will explore how original scholarly research is done in interdisciplinary Canadian Studies, including the processes, issues, and challenges involved, in Canada and around the world.

This course is designed to equip students with a basic understanding of the mechanics, ethics, dilemmas, and rewards of scholarly research on Canada: asking a research question, reviewing the field, planning a project in terms of research, methodology, and organization of findings.

The Carleton E-portfolio will be introduced and used as means to professionalization through growing students' voice and polishing academic production & representation.
