INDG 1011* [0.5 credit]: Introduction to Indigenous Settler Encounters

ONLINE SYNCHRONOUS

An interdisciplinary examination of the history of relations between different Indigenous peoples and settler populations from first meetings to the mid-20th century. Topics vary by year, but may include diplomatic relations, trade, spirituality and religion, military alliances, policy, education.

Precludes additional credit for [INDG 1000](#).

Previous teaching experience in the subject area is an asset for the courses listed above. Doctoral students must be post-comps to be considered. Review of applications and hiring decisions will be made in accordance with the CUPE 4600 (Unit 2) Collective Agreement. Please note that the review of applications will commence no earlier than 21 calendar days after the date posted and continue until the position is filled. All positions are subject to budgetary approval.

*For positions in **Indigenous Studies**, the required minimum qualifications are a graduate degree in Indigenous Studies or a related field. Given the nature of our programs, candidates are also required to have familiarity with Indigenous pedagogical approaches and a record of collaboration with Indigenous communities and organizations.

A note to all applicants: As per Articles 16.3-16.4 in the CUPE 4600-2 Collective Agreement, the posted vacancies listed above are first offered to applicants meeting the incumbency criterion.
