

Grants for PhD and Post-doctoral participation research travel Jean Monnet Network in EU-Canada Relations



The Jean Monnet Network on EU-Canada Relations (hereafter The Network) has funding to support research visits by PhD students or post-doctoral fellows from Network universities at other Network universities: Carleton University (Ottawa, Canada); University of Antwerp (Belgium); Technical University Darmstadt (Germany), Technical University Munich (Germany), and the University of Latvia.

The grants will support *PhD Student and Post-doctoral Fellow Research Visits of 2-3 weeks to other Network universities* to conduct research, consult with experts, or make use of research materials related to an ongoing research project. Grants will reimburse documented travel and living expenses; the amount will depend on travel itinerary and the availability of funds. All research visits must be completed by October 31, 2022. You will be expected to give a research seminar during your visit.

Eligibility

- You must be enrolled as a PhD student or formally affiliated as a post-doctoral fellow with one of the Network universities during the time of participation
- Participation should make a demonstrable contribution to the focus of your research project, which should relate to EU-Canada relations or EU studies.

Please submit an expression of interest including the following information:

- a letter explaining: (a) the reasons for your interest in participating; (b) how it relates to your research program; (c) which Network university you wish to visit and why; and (d) the proposed time period for your visit.
- a resume
- a letter of support from your local faculty affiliated with the network. A list of faculty is available here: <https://carleton.ca/caneunet/all-researchers-staff/>
