# Regional Inequalities in Central and Eastern Europe: The Impact of the EU

Professor Kozak, of the European Centre for Regional and Local Studies at the University of Warsaw, is engaged in research on regional structural EU policy, evaluation studies, and tourism in regional and local development. He is a member of the State Council for Spatial Economy, the Committee for Space Economy and Regional Planning at the Presidium of the Polish Academy of Sciences, and of the Executive Board of Regional Studies Association, Polish Section.

In this lecture, Professor Kozak will look at the levels of disparities in Central and Eastern Europe and the dynamics of change after 1989. Both disparities within and between new member states will be analyzed, and the region's key challenge of adopting of a new development paradigm will be examined.
