Curriculum Vitae

Metin Hakverdi is serving as the Coordinator of Transatlantic Cooperation for the German Government. He has been a member of the German Bundestag since 2013 and currently serves on the Bundestag's Committee on European Union Affairs. He is the deputy chairman of the German-American Parliamentary Friendship Group, chairman of the USA discussion group of the SPD parliamentary group in the Bundestag, and a member of the board of Atlantik-Brücke. Metin Hakverdi was a John F. Kennedy Memorial Policy Fellow at Harvard University and a Distinguished Visitor at the American Institute for Contemporary German Studies at Johns Hopkins University.

Before being elected to the Bundestag, Mr. Hakverdi was a member of the Parliament of the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg from 2008 to 2013.

He attended high school in Simi Valley, California, in 1985/86 and studied law at the Christian-Albrechts University in Kiel and at Indiana University's Maurer School of Law.
