EU Study Tour 2024 Report on travel support from the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence

"The funds provided by the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence greatly aided in offsetting some of the initial costs of the EU study tour. In the EU Study Tour, we visited multiple European countries and cities such as Maastricht in the Netherlands, Frankfurt in Germany, Luxemburg and Brussels in Belgium.
