The culture and society are set in their historical context and studied through readings from representative ancient authors (in English translation) and through the art and architecture of the period. Early Summer (May-June)	CLCV 2500/ENGL 2500 Classical Mythology Modality: Online (Asynchronous or Synchronous TBD) Course Description: A study of classical mythology, emphasizing its use in Greek and Roman literature and its place in classical art and religion. There is some discussion of classical myths in terms of contemporary interpretations of myth.	December 7, 2022
