Strengthening Carleton's Indo-Pacific Partnerships (SCIPP)
Application Form for Student Research Fellowship at Project Partners

This application is for a research fellowship under the Carleton International project **Strengthening Carleton's Indo-Pacific Partnerships (SCIPP)**, funded by the **Government of Canada**. Students are invited to apply for a research placement at a Project Partner. The proposed research must fit with the requirements specified by the Project Partner and be aligned with the [Strategic Objectives of Canada's Indo-Pacific Strategy](#). The amount of the award is \$10,000 CAD to support travel, insurance, and living expenses during the visit.

Only Canadian Citizens, Permanent Residents, and graduate students enrolled in a program at Carleton are eligible to apply. Successful candidates will be selected based on fit of student's background and interests with the Project Partner, alignment of the research activities with the Strategic Objectives of Canada's Indo-Pacific Strategy, strength of the research plan, equitable country distribution and GBA+ considerations.

Candidates selected by Carleton will be nominated to the partner institution for additional review and final approval. Note that Letters of Invitation are **not required** with the application to Project Partners, as **students will be matched with supervisors following the selection of successful candidates**. A letter of support from the home supervisor is required.
