Erasmus+ Student mobility at Üsküdar University (Türkiye)

Submission Deadline **March 30, 2026**

Host institution: Üsküdar University

Host Country: Türkiye

Funding Program: Erasmus+

Mobilities available: 1 student mobility for research at any level for a minimum 5 months.

Open to the following Department(s) or Faculty: Any

Timeframe for mobility: Fall semester or academic year (2026/27)

OPPORTUNITY

This opportunity is for one Carleton student at any level (undergraduate, Master's or PhD) to visit Üsküdar University for research. Üsküdar University Will provide funding for travel and living expense through the Erasmus+ program. The visit must be at least five months. Students should find a potential supervisor at Üsküdar before applying. website [here](#).

ELIGIBILITY

The opportunity is open to students at Carleton who are registered full-time in any program and at any level of study. Undergraduate students must have completed at least two regular semesters. Graduate students must have completed at least one regular semester.

FUNDING

Selected candidates will receive financial assistance to cover subsistence costs during the mobility period as well as travel expenses, as specified below:

- **Individual Support (Subsistence): 4.000,00 €.**
- **Travel Support: 1.735,00 €.**
- **Total Grant: 5.735,00 €.**

HOW TO APPLY

Applications must include:

- **CV** (short, max 5 pages)
- **Letter of motivation** that outlines why you are interested in this opportunity, and how the visit will benefit your academic and professional development. Any other information the applicant deems pertinent may also be included (i.e. additional skills, interests, vulnerable socio-economic status, etc.) (1-2 pages)
- **Proposed research plan** outlining the research activities that will take place over the 5 months (library and archives, lab work, travel to sites, fieldwork, etc.) (1-2 pages)

Note: a letter of invitation is not required at this time; however, the applicant should find a supervisor at Üsküdar and contact them prior to applying. The application materials should specify the department and/or lab where the student will be hosted and the faculty member they will work with.

Please send complete applications to Carleton International at mobility.programs@carleton.ca by the deadline.

You will be contacted within 4 weeks of the deadline with the results of the competition.

EVALUATION

Teaching and/or non-teaching staff will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- a. Previous experience / research (CV): *20 points*
 - b. Letter of motivation: *40 points*
 - c. Proposed research plan: *40 points*
- Lower priority will be given to those who have previously participated in an Erasmus+ mobility.
 - Students with disabilities will receive 5 points if substitutive documents are provided in the application.
 - Students who want to participate in the mobility programs in their birth country receive -5 points.

Following the evaluation of applications and selection of a top candidate, Carleton International will nominate the selected candidate to the host institution for final confirmation. Once the host institution validates the nominated candidate, the International/Erasmus Office will communicate the results of the selection process to applicants. Submission of additional documents in an online portal at the host institution will be required to confirm the nomination.

CONDITIONS

- The mobility opportunities available in this call corresponds to funding granted by the European Commission to the host institution and is based on an inter-institutional agreement between the host institution and Carleton University.
- The areas of knowledge of the eligible participants will be those indicated in the interinstitutional agreement signed between the ITU and Carleton University for the purposes of this call.
- The selected candidate must accept a Mobility/Learning/Teaching Agreement before departure, which describes the activities to be completed during the mobility period and the responsibilities of each party. The mobility agreement will be endorsed and signed by the mobility participant and respective institutional signatories at Carleton University and the host institution.
- The selected candidate must complete steps that may be required by Carleton and/or the host institution to participate in international mobility.
- This call for applications will be published on the Carleton International website, along with the selected candidates once they are confirmed.
- Deductions and/or repayment may apply to students who do not fulfill their responsibilities.
