Erasmus+ Student mobility at Universidad de Murcia (Spain)

Mobilities available: 1 student mobility for research at PhD level

Open to the following Department(s) or Faculty: Any

Duration of mobility: 3 months

Timeframe for mobility: Between September 2026 and July 2027

ELIGIBILITY

The opportunity is open to students at Carleton who are registered in a PhD program.

FUNDING

Selected candidates will receive financial assistance to cover subsistence costs during the mobility period as well as travel expenses, as specified below:

- **Monthly allowance:** 850 €.
- **Travel Grant:** 1,188 €.
- **Total Grant:** 3,738,00 €.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications must include:

- **CV** (short, max 5 pages)
- **Letter or email of support from Carleton supervisor**
- **Letter of motivation (2-3 pages)** with the following information:
 - Why you are interested in this opportunity and how the visit will benefit your professional development
 - Research topic or field, based on doctoral programs at Murcia listed here: [Doctorados - Escuela Internacional de Doctorado - Universidad de Murcia](#)
 - The advisor at Murcia you want to work with, whether you have contacted them, or if you need to be matched following approval
 - The Research activities to be completed during the visit.
 - Any other information deemed pertinent may also be included (i.e. additional skills, interests, vulnerable socio-economic status, etc.)

Note: applicants may but don't need to identify a host supervisor at this time. The Erasmus office at Murcia will help nominated students find an advisor. However, the applicant should specify the research field of interest from the PhD programmes available at Murcia: <https://www.um.es/web/eidum/estudios/doctorados>

Please send complete applications to Carleton International at mobility.programs@carleton.ca by the deadline.

You will be contacted within 1 week of the deadline with the results of the competition.

EVALUATION

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- a. Previous experience / research (CV): *40 points*
- b. Letter of motivation: *60 points*

Priority will be given to individuals **who have not yet completed** an Erasmus+ mobility stay previously, as well as candidates with fewer opportunities.

Following the evaluation of applications and selection of a top candidate, Carleton International will nominate the selected candidate to the host institution for final confirmation. Once the host institution validates the nominated candidate, the International/Erasmus Office will communicate the results of the selection process to applicants. Submission of additional documents in an online portal at the host institution will be required to confirm the nomination.

CONDITIONS

- The mobility opportunities available in this call corresponds to funding granted by the European Commission to the host institution and is based on an inter-institutional agreement between the host institution and Carleton University.
- The areas of knowledge of the eligible participants will be those indicated in the interinstitutional agreement signed between the host institution and Carleton University for the purposes of this call.
- The selected candidate must accept a Mobility Agreement before departure, which describes the activities to be completed during the mobility period and the responsibilities of each party. The mobility agreement will be endorsed and signed by the mobility participant and respective institutional signatories at Carleton University and the host institution.

- The selected candidate must complete steps that may be required by Carleton and/or the host institution to participate in international mobility.
- This call for applications will be published on the Carleton International website, along with the selected candidates once they are confirmed.
