








 - Taskable deep analysis of particular countries and regions of interest






CEWS Next steps



- Strategic country and regional analysis


















Potential Applications Canadian Early Warning Service (CEWS)

- HUD display for policymakers
 - At-a-glance summary of situations worldwide, providing deep analysis in a readily accessible and actionable form
- Drill-down capability for mid-level analysts
 - If desired, can provide access to the foundations of analysis, rendering conclusions transparent to all users
- Creation of a common pool of knowledge for broad range of Canadian actors
 - Enables cooperation in unstable environments, providing common basis for analysis of the problem and generation of potential solutions
