



Research process

• Questions: How knowledge can be mobilised through student engagement in the community. What is the impact of student engagement on community? What are good practices? And what are the difficulties?

• Interviews: Extensive interviews done with students, community partners and

practicum coordinators.







 Support: students need ongoing support to work in community organizations so that they can take responsibility for their own learning

 Building Respect: recognition that community partners hold considerable knowledge which needs to be better understood and respected in University programs
