All students in the Criminology BA program have the same first year requirements. Starting second year, the requirements differ based on one of four chosen paths.

Major in Criminology and Criminal Justice

Second year: Criminological Theories, Contemporary Issues in

Criminology and Criminal Justice.

Third year: Quantitative Methods in Criminology, Qualitative Methods in Criminology, 2.5 credits in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 3000-level or higher.

Additional two courses (1.0 credit) of choice at second and/or third year from a list of Law, Sociology, or Psychology options.

Fourth year: 1.0 credit in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 4000-level or higher.

Major in Criminology and Criminal Justice: Concentration in Law

Second year: Criminological Theories, Contemporary Issues in Criminology and Criminal Justice, Criminal Justice System, Criminal Law, Methodological Approaches in Legal Studies I, Forensic Psychology, Crime and Society, Additional credits in Law and Legal Studies.

Third year: Quantitative Methods in Criminology, Qualitative Methods in Criminology, Criminal Behaviour, Studies in Criminal Justice, 1.5 credits in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 3000-level or higher, Additional credits in Law and Legal Studies.

Fourth year: 1.0 credit in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 4000-level or higher.

Major in Criminology and Criminal Justice: Concentration in Sociology

Second year: Criminological Theories, Contemporary Issues in Criminology and Criminal Justice, Criminal Justice System, Criminal Law, Forensic Psychology, Crime and Society, Foundations of Sociological Inquiry, Introduction to Qualitative Research Methods, Additional credits in Sociology.

Third year: Quantitative Methods in Criminology, Criminal Behaviour, Studies in Criminal Justice, 1.5 credits in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 3000-level or higher, Additional credits in Sociology.

Fourth year: 1.0 credit in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 4000-level or higher.

Major in Criminology and Criminal Justice: Concentration in Mind and Behaviour

Second year: Criminological Theories, Contemporary Issues in Criminology and Criminal Justice, Justice and the Self, Criminal Justice System, Criminal Law, Introduction to Forensic Psychology, Crime and Society.

Third year: Quantitative Methods in Criminology, Qualitative Methods in Criminology, Mental Health and Criminalization, Criminal Behaviour, Studies in Criminal Justice. A 0.5 credit in one of the following courses: Addictions, Police Psychology, Psychology of Motivation and Emotion, or Special Topics in Mind and Behaviour. 1.5 credits in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 3000-level or higher.

Fourth year: 1.0 credit in CRCJ or Approved CCJ electives at the 4000-level or higher.

Notes

- CRCJ 1000 can be taken in either the Fall or Winter term.
- Throughout each year in the program, you will take elective requirements alongside the listed major requirements.
- Course value: half credit [0.5] or full credit [1.0]
- Students must verify that they have all prerequisites before registering for a course
