Information Sheet CRCJ 4910 & CRCJ 4920 Independent Study in Criminology and Criminal Justice

The Independent Study in Criminology and Criminal Justice (CRCJ 4910 or 4920) is a reading or research course conducted under the supervision of a faculty advisor from Criminology and Criminal Justice, Psychology, Law or Sociology. This course gives students the opportunity to develop a 0.5 credit class that aligns with their own interests and to explore alternative research. Students are responsible for finding a faculty member to supervise this course. Students may not include more than 1.0 credit of independent study in their total program.

Pre-requisite(s): Fourth-year standing in the B.A. Honours program in Criminology and Criminal Justice and permission of the Institute.
