Support will be provided to projects that align with the CSPSC goals and mandate.

The main objectives of the CSPSC include:

- Primarily, to support and promote research conducted within the [Carleton School of Social Work \(SSW\)](#) relating to matters of poverty and social citizenship
- To partner with external faculty, researchers and non-profits devoted to promoting poverty reduction and social citizenship through research and outreach activities including presentations, workshops, forums and other educational events
- To provide research opportunities for social work students interested in poverty reduction and social citizenship by creating research assistant positions and/or by supporting SSW student research
- To support new, ongoing and innovative research work in the [Carleton School of Social Work \(SSW\)](#)
