CURA Annual General Meeting Minutes Thursday, May 25, 2023, 13:00-14:00 Zoom Video

1. Welcoming Remarks by Provost and VP (Academic) – Jerry Tomberlin

It has been customary for the Provost to open our two Annual Meetings and provide updates on current events at Carleton. He chairs a Coordinating Committee, which meets twice a year, and is attended by the CURA President, Vice-President, Past President, and Mandy Hair from Human Resources. Jerry and Mandy facilitate any request we may have from the University. The Provost provided the following update:

- Last year was another challenging but successful year with a successful return to campus face-to-face. It is a process and not a done deal yet. It will be interesting to see what the new normal will be.
- Our Research continues to improve. Since 2018 our 3-year rolling average was about \$55M, then \$71M, and \$86M. In 2023, it is \$97.4M and estimated to surpass the \$100M mark next year.
- In terms of fund-raising, the 3-year rolling average is \$25M to \$35M and about \$40M in 2023.
- This has been a success with integrated partnerships that we have between the Office of the VP (Research & International) and Advancement. We have adopted a unified approach in terms of philanthropy and research support.
- We have a new campus master plan going out to the future when things like the LRT run which has been promised for October. The Nicol Building was officially opened last September. The new Engineering Design Centre is now up and running. Also, construction on the new residence is now above ground.
- This may be Jerry's last AGM as Provost. The search is ongoing for a new Provost and Jerry is looking forward to joining CURA.

There was a round of applause for Jerry's support over the years. A question was asked when the annual Spring Conference will be re-instated. That would be the decision of the new Provost.

- We continue to request to have a retiree on the Carleton Pension Committee. Eugene Swimmer is our chosen rep and this matter is still in progress.

5. CURAC Update – Wendy Watkins

Wendy Watkins, our CURAC rep, was unable to attend and sent her update to Susan Nesrallah to report.

CURAC stands for College & University Retiree Associations of Canada, and is an umbrella organization of 40 retiree associations of which we are a member. It's non-profit providing and coordinating activities that promote communication and sharing of information among member associations. They provide mutual assistance and speak publicly on issues of concern to the over 15,000 retired members across Canada. They have several partners that provide travel planning and discounts, travel cancellation insurance, interruption insurance, home, car and pet insurance.

Finally, CURAC is holding its annual conference, this year in Saskatoon, from May 31st to June 2nd. The theme is "The New World" focusing on higher education, societal changes, research and development and health services. David Holmes will be attending as a member of the CURAC conference organizing committee. David added that this is the 20th Anniversary of CURAC, and they will be hosting a talk by Roy Romanow along with the presentations. Next year's conference will be held at the University of Waterloo.
