WHAT TO DO

- Sign up for local alerts and warnings
 - o Learn the difference between Warnings, Watches and Advisories
- Create and test emergency communication plans
- Stock up on emergency supplies
 - Create winter emergency supplies kits for yourself, home and car
- Winterize your home
 - Make sure your pipes are insulated and CO detectors are properly installed
- Review and safeguard critical documents
 - Don't forget to have copies on hand in your emergency supplies kits
- Get trained on specific needs for yourself and/or family
- Identify a location where you can go to warm up should your house lose heat

During

WHAT TO DO

- Stay indoors and off roads
 - If you must drive, don't forget to keep an emergency supplies kit in your car
- Close off unused rooms to conserve heat
- Dress in layers and use blankets to keep warm
- Bring pets inside and out of the cold
- Never use a generator or portable gas-powered heat source inside
 - These items can start accidental fires, cause electric shocks or CO poisoning
- Never heat a home with a cook-top oven
- Limit your time outdoors and stay dry

After

WHAT TO DO

- Only drive if necessary
 - Clean snow and ice off your car before you drive
- Dress in warm clothing and avoid going outdoors
 - Prolonged exposure to cold temperatures can lead to hypothermia
- Monitor local news alerts for emergency information and instructions
