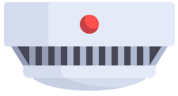


# Fire Safety Tips

## HOME SAFETY

### SMOKE ALARMS



- Install smoke alarms in frequented areas around your home
- Test your smoke alarms regularly, and change the batteries when necessary

### USE PROPER STORAGE



- DO NOT store liquids near electronics
- Storage spaces should be kept tidy and easily accessible

### FIRE EXTINGUISHERS



- Invest in a fire extinguisher for your home and car to keep handy in the event of fire
- Learn how to properly use your fire extinguisher and have it inspected regularly

### KEEP YOUR SPACE CLEAN



- Keep your living spaces clean to prevent accidents
- Everything in your home should have its own place
- Keep hallways, doors and windows free of clutter

### MAINTAIN EQUIPMENT



- Avoid tangling electrical cords, and do not use cords that are damaged
- There should be no exposed wiring or ungrounded circuits

### HAVE A PLAN



- Have an escape plan to get yourself to safety in the event of a fire
- DO NOT re-enter the building to retrieve forgotten items
