2 Register and Post

Prepare a job description and submit your job posting easily online. All jobs are posted on CUHire, so you will need to create an employer account.

3 Review

Students apply to your job (via CUHire and/or company website), and an application bundle is sent to your email inbox after the application deadline has passed. Applications are also accessible via your CUHire account.

4 Interviews

Select your interview candidates, and the Co-op Office will coordinate and confirm interview arrangements on your behalf. Interviews can take place in our interview space on campus, by telephone or Skype, or at your location.

5 Hire

The Co-op Office will extend offers to your selected student(s) on your behalf. No rank and match! Our flexible approach allows for continuous hiring, where students are interviewed and hired on a first-come, first-served basis.


