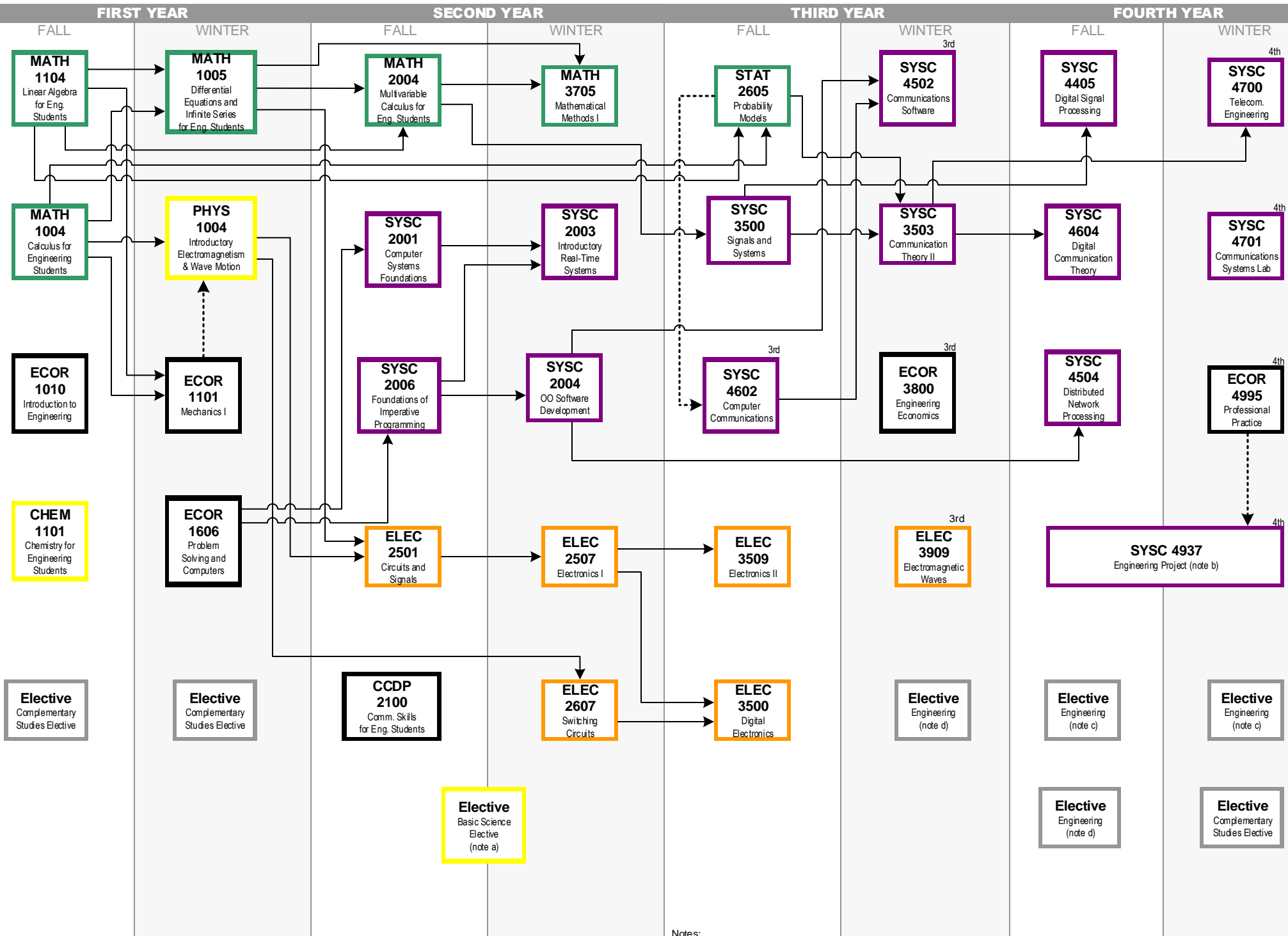


# COMMUNICATIONS ENGINEERING
