

Engineering Practice Stream Representatives – Responsibilities

1. Stream Advocacy

- Act as a voice for your stream within the Engineering Practice Program.
- Share the interests, challenges, and innovations of your stream in meetings with EP administration.

2. Community Engagement

- Foster a sense of community and collaboration among stream students.
- Stay actively connected with stream members through group chats, meetings, and/or informal check-ins.
- Encourage inclusive participation in EP activities, including surveys and feedback initiatives.

3. Communication & Coordination

- Attend meetings with other stream representatives and EP leadership.
- Communicate updates, decisions, and opportunities from EP leadership back to your stream.

4. Feedback & Program Improvement

- Gather feedback from stream members on EP course offerings, initiatives, events, and resources.
- Provide insights and recommendations to EP leadership to support continuous improvement.
- Monitor the impact of EP initiatives within your stream and suggest adjustments as needed.

5. Program Support

- Assist EP with organizing elections (online) for future stream representatives.
- Support the coordination of exit focus group interviews and/ or exit surveys for graduating students.
- Support EP events and initiatives as needed (e.g., socializing with new students during EP orientations for onboarding students).
