ISCI 2002 [0.5 credit]

Human Impacts on the Environment

Air and water pollution; global climatic change; waste management; industrial chemicals; sources and uses of energy; nuclear energy and radiation; risk assessment of technological hazards.

Acceptable only as a free elective in a Science program.

Prerequisite: [ISCI 2000](#) or [ISCI 1002](#) or two experimental science grade 12 U/M courses or one first year university experimental science credit.

Lectures/demonstrations three hours a week and project assignments.

Qualifications

- Strong background in chemistry
- Experience in multidisciplinary teaching, in particular teaching classes made up of students from all the faculties who have a wide range of literacy and numeracy skills
- Enthusiasm for the teaching

Other required documents must be relevant to judge qualifications and should not require applicants to provide details as to how they would shape or teach the course.

(b) When applying to classes for which they have incumbency, applicants shall not be required to (re)submit documentation beyond their updated CV.
