Our application requires that you submit transcripts, letters of reference, a personal statement and an application fee. The details are listed in checklist below.

- Physics with a minimum grade of 60% (Physics does not need to be complete prior to enrolling with IESP)

- Chemistry with a minimum grade of 60%

Your *Personal Statement* should be between 750-1,000 words (please type and double-space) and should have three parts (Parts A, B and C):

Part A: Academic History

- Please comment on your high school record (and/or college/university, if applicable) and any reasons you think your previous academic record may not reflect your potential.
- What, if any, challenges did you face in high school (and/or college/university, if applicable), for example: family issues, academic, personal, disability, etc.? How did you address them?
- How you plan to ensure that you successfully address these or similar challenges while at university?

Part B: Academic Goals

- Why do you wish to attend university, what do you want to study and why?
- How will attending university help you achieve your (educational, personal and/or career) goals?

Part C: Why IESP is right for you

(Be sure to read up on our program on our website in order to help you address this section.)

- How can the program help you achieve your goals? Please be specific about what aspects of the program you feel will be helpful to you and why.
- The Seminars and Workshops both call for working with other students, often in groups. Tell us about your strengths and weaknesses in groups. Have you had problems with group work in the past, how will you address these problems in the future?
- What aspects of Indigenous culture are you most familiar with and/or interested in? For example, some Indigenous students are interested in discovering more about their heritage. Others are interested in finding out more about the Indigenous politics/treaties across the country.

Please provide your referee with a copy of these guidelines. When you receive your reference letter from your reference, do not open the envelope. Submit the sealed envelope with your application package.

Guidelines for Letter:

Please identify the applicant, the capacity in which you came to know him/her, and the length of your acquaintance. Include an assessment of the applicant's personal qualifications and suitability for university study.

Any information you can provide on the following areas would be helpful:

- communication skills (written and/or oral)
- willingness to take initiative
- level of motivation
- planning and organizational skills
- flexibility and adaptability
- willingness to accept responsibility
- leadership, analytical, problem-solving ability
- interpersonal skills, group interaction and team-working skills.

Please provide examples of the qualities you describe.

What are the applicant's strengths and weaknesses? Has he/she made efforts to address areas of concern?
