You're almost there!! Now that you have been accepted to ESP, here is a checklist to help keep track of your next steps and get you ready. So get started!

	1) RETURN THE FORMS Return your signed acceptance and consent forms. If you were conditionally admitted, please provide the necessary documents once available.
	2) KNOW YOUR STUDENT NUMBER You need this number to sign into Carleton's student portal. Don't know it? Applying for OSAP/ Residence? Contact us and we'll help
	3) APPLY FOR STUDENT LOANS Click HERE to apply for OSAP: - Your program: ESP - Your course load: 100% *All communication will be sent to your Carleton email*
	4) SET UP YOUR CARLETON EMAIL AND
	MYCARLETONONE ACCOUNT Your Carleton email (cmail) will be the university's official means of communicating with you. Your MyCarletonOne account will be the username and passwords that you use to access Carleton's IT resources. Please see your "Next Steps" email for more information.
1	5) READ OVER YOUR REGISTRATION INFORMATION You will receive a registration email by late-July. Registration information is posted to our website: carleton.ca/esp/registration
	6) REGISTER FOR YOUR CLASSES Watch our step-by-step registration video posted to our registration website in the 'Course Planning' section in any of the streams. If you have any further questions, sign up for our stream-specific Group Advising Sessions or send us an email esp@carleton.ca
	7) ATTEND A REQUIRED ESP WELCOME VISIT In August, you will receive an email invitation to come to the ESP Coaching Office (1510 Dunton Tower) for a required pre-orientation Welcome Visit with an Academic Coach. Got questions? Email us at academic.coaching@carleton.ca . A coach will help you before classes start, with questions you didn't even know you had!
	8) CHECK YOUR TIMETABLE Check your timetable on Carleton Central (central.carleton.ca) approximately 5 days after submitting your course selection form.

	12) GET YOUR CAMPUS CARD AND UPASS The campus card gives you access to the library, athletic facilities, residence meal plans and more! *Please note ESP students must be registered in their courses and are able to view their timetable on Carleton Central before being eligible to receive cards.	
	11) KEEP TRACK OF DEADLINES Pay special attention to academic deadlines at <u>carleton.ca/registration/dates</u> . You will be receiving regular Advising Bulletins to your Carleton email that will have important information about deadlines.
