3) APPLY FOR STUDENT LOANS Click HERE to apply for OSAP: - Your program: ESP - Your course load: 100% *All communication will be sent to your Carleton email*
4) SET UP YOUR CARLETON EMAIL AND
MYCARLETONONE ACCOUNT Your Carleton email (cmail) will be the university's official means of communicating with you. Your MyCarletonOne account will be the username and passwords that you use to access Carleton's IT resources. Please see your "Next Steps" email for more information.
5) READ OVER YOUR REGISTRATION INFORMATION You will receive a registration email by late-July. Registration information is posted to our website: carleton.ca/esp/registration
