
Click to agree that you've read and understood, then click "Save and continue".




Search for your Bachelor's degree program:




One you select the degree, the list of possible majors will appear:




Then the various options for that major will be listed (such as majors with concentrations or specializations, and/or double-majors). Select the + symbol to add the program you want.






Then you will be offered the option of adding a minor if you wish:



Then you can add a second degree choice to your application. Repeat the same steps to find your program and minor (optional).




You will then be shown your current contact info and asked to add a personal email. You can't edit your phone number here. If you want to update your number, you'll need to do so in Carleton Central after submitting your application.



The next section asks for your college or university academic history.

- No need to add your ESP studies, they'll have access to those.
- If you studied at another university or at college, and you applied to a degree at Carleton in the past, they should have those studies listed as well.
 - If you applied directly to ESP and not to a degree, you'll need to add your college and/or other university studies.
 - This means you'll be charged a fee to assess those studies for possible transfer credit. You can pay it now or later through a link provided in Carleton 360.
 - o If you provided ESP with an original transcript, then you don't need to provide another. We'll scan it into the system so admissions can access it.
