





- Support navigating workplace accommodations, disclosure conversations, and employment as it relates to disability

- Work term support (check-ins, counselling, accommodation implementation)
- Individual counselling with a disability and career development lens
- Disclosure and accommodation conversations
- Post-work-term support and resources
- Support for students enrolled in Carleton's Cooperative Program
