**Reminder to pay your tuition**

Winter 2026 tuition deadline was November 25, 2025, unless you had a deferral because you are receiving OSAP; then it's January 13.

- Late charges and interest will be applied if not paid.
- Check your balance in Carleton Central, Registration: Calculate amount to pay.

What happens if you don't pay?

- March 12th, a financial hold preventing registration will be applied
- April 8th, will not be able to see final grades in Carleton Central
- Monthly interest will continue to be charged to your account

## Applying for your degree

To apply for a program, come in and meet with an Academic Advisor. Don't use OUAC - as a Carleton student, you apply using Carleton 360.

### Deadlines:

- **March 1st:** Architecture, Engineering, Computer Science, Humanities, Industrial Design, Information Technology (Interactive Multimedia and Design), Journalism, Music and Social Work.
- **June 1st:** This is the general deadline for all remaining programs, including all in the Bachelor of Arts (such as Criminology, English, Psychology, Sociology and so on), Business, Economics, Global and International Studies, Cognitive Science, Science, etc.

The deadline to switch a Winter term course is this **Friday, January 16th**. If you would like to go over your options with an advisor please send us an [email](#) or pop by our office for drop in hours (Daily 8:30 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm)

The financial withdrawal deadline is **January 31st**. You can withdraw from courses up until March 15, but January 31st is the last date to withdraw and receive a refund of winter term fees.

You need to request a withdrawal from an academic advisor either by email: [esp.advising@carleton.ca](mailto:esp.advising@carleton.ca) or popping by the ESP office for our drop in hours during the month of January. Drop in hours are Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 12:00 pm and 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm.
