Kinross Fund for Russian Studies

Kinross Bursaries for Russian Studies are awarded annually to the outstanding graduate students in the Institute of European, Russian and Eurasian Studies (EURUS), who are studying Russia, Russian language and/or Russian relations with the outside world.

Awards will not normally exceed Can \$ 1100 dollars in this round.

Eligibility and criteria:

This bursary may be awarded to students for field research, language training, or other legitimate scholarly travel expenses (for example, presentations at conferences or workshops). Recipients will be chosen by a Committee struck by the Dean of the Faculty of Public Affairs. The committee will include Dr. Piotr Dutkiewicz (Kinross Fund Coordinator), Dr. Achim Hurrelmann and Dr. Jeff Sahadeo.

(Note: The Kinross Bursary for Russian Studies can only be awarded once to a student during his/her degree program).

Applications should include:

- A short letter of application (a half page to one page max.), outlining the importance of the travel and purpose of the bursary;
- For conference or workshop participation, an abstract of the paper and indication of acceptance of the paper by the conference organizers;
- A listing of other support that is expected or has been applied for and justification of the amount requested from the Magna Fund.
